#### **Heath Ledger Theatre Capacity**

Heath Ledger Theatre has a capacity of 575 seats which comprises of 170 in the circle and 405 in the stalls (including 39 removable on the orchestra pit / forestage lift). All rows are curved to face the stage and each row is elevated above the one in front enabling unobstructed sight lines. For disabled seating there are 22 removable seats in the stalls and three in the circle (not including the 39 on the orchestra pit).

#### **Studio Underground Capacity**

The Studio Underground is a 'black box' type studio with flat floor and gallery on three sides which connects to the Middar Room. There is a maximum seating capacity of 234 seats depending on seating format. Each row is in retractable units elevated above the one in front. Disabled seating locations are available both on the flat floor and in the gallery.

| Toilets                      | Located at foyer bar level (which is also front stalls)   |

| Formats                     | The Studio is primarily and end stage venue, other configurations are possible but depending on requirements externally hired seating rostra may be required |
| Sight Lines                 | Each row in retractable units is elevated above the one in front   |
| Disabled Seating            | Locations available both on the flat floor and in the gallery  |
| Studio Size                 | 20 metres wide x 19 metres high x 6.7 metres to tension wire grid (lighting above this), public/technical gallery on three sides                             |
| Side Stage – Dock           | 34m <sup>2</sup> – leads to loading bay via goods lift and to stage – latter via 3 metre wide x 3 metre high doors (to be confirmed)                         |
| Stage Floor                 | Sprung timber sacrificial surface, no floor traps  |
| Studio Grid                 | Tensioned wire grid for over 60 per cent, remainder is catwalk access with flown box trusses over the stage in default end stage configuration               |
| Foyer                       | Single foyer at gallery level with bars, toilets, lifts plus access to Rehearsal Room I  |
| Lifts                       | Lifts serve foyer and studio floor levels  |
| Toilets                     | Located on foyer bar level   |
| Lifts                       | Lifts serve all levels including front stalls, rear stalls and circle levels   |
| Toilets                     | Located at foyer bar level (which is also front stalls)  |

| Dimensions                 | 23m wide x 20m high   |
| Floor                      | Brick with landscaping  |
| Entrances                  | From William Street and/or James Street and/or from the Box Office concourse          |
| Tickets                    | Tickets can be sold into The Courtyard without requiring access to the main concourse |


#### **Seating Plan**




#### **Studio Underground Seating Plan**

#### 234 Seats

The Studio Underground is a 'black box' type studio with a flat floor and gallery on three sides which connects to Rehearsal Room I. There is a maximum seating capacity of 234 seats depending on seating format. Each row is in retractable units elevated above the one in front. Balcony seats are high backed stools. Disabled seating locations are available both on the flat floor and in the gallery.

# Heath Ledger Theatre Backstage Facilities

| Bump-In / Deliveries | Loading Bay on Roe Street<br>Two bays each for 40' x high Maxi Cube semis                               |
|----------------------|---|
| Dressing Rooms       | Four rooms stage level for 10, five, five and three people<br>All equipped with showers, toilets, safes |
| Lifts                | To all backstage levels, including a lift in the fly tower  |
| Other BOH Facilities | Wardrobe, laundry, visiting SM, basic workshop, 10 person multi- purpose room                           |
| Storage              | Under stage, plus two rooms by main stage and portable cages for equipment                              |
| Toilets              | Universal at stage level, plus one under stage level that includes shower facilities                    |

# Studio Underground Backstage Facilities

| Bump-In / Deliveries    | Via Roe Street loading bay as for Heath Ledger Theatre, then via goods lift                       |

| Dressing Rooms          | Three rooms at stage level for 10, five and five people<br>All include showers, toilets and safes |
| Lifts                   | To all backstage levels   |
| Other<br>BOH Facilities | As for Heath Ledger Theatre, two floors above   |
| Storage                 | Room adjacent to dock, portable cages for equipment   |
| Toilets                 | Universal at stage level  |

#### **The Courtyard Backstage Facilities**

The backstage facilities for the Studio Underground and Heath Ledger Theatre will be utilised for The Courtyard performance space.

The Courtyard has its own toilet facilities, including a universal access toilet.

| Location              | Basement level, accessed via backstage or Studio Underground foyer  |

| Function              | Rehearsals, small performances, functions, connects to through to the studio for larger events  |
| Dimensions            | 13.7 metres x 22 metres x 5.8 metres  |
| Facilities            | Kitchenette, lighting grid, barres, mirrors, sprung floor with sacrificial surface and<br>light, surround drapes; services connection to the Heath Ledger Theatre and Studio<br>Underground |
| Lighting<br>Equipment | There is no lighting equipment permanently rigged in this space; equipment will be provided from available STC stock. Power Supply and rigging positions provided.                          |
